DESIGN NOTICE – NE Holman & 13th Improvement Project

Why am I receiving this notice?

The Portland Bureau of Transportation is beginning work on a roadway narrowing and stormwater facility adjacent to the “pocket park” at NE Holman and NE 13th to safely manage the interactions between cyclists, pedestrians and reduce “cut through” traffic avoiding congestion on NE Ainsworth.

This project consists of narrowing the roadway and providing a barrier to motor vehicle traffic on NE Holman while maintaining pedestrian and cyclist connectivity. The stormwater feature will also reduce ponding at this location and also manage and treat stormwater cost effectively.

Initial designs had shown the stormwater feature on 13th, however, the updated design right-sizes the facility and places the feature on Holman north of the existing pocket park.

Currently both the Bureau of Environmental Services and the Bureau of Transportation are working with Portland Parks & Recreation to determine what, if any, changes can be made in the park with the adjacent area and also how to provide some level of maintenance for the new area.

All three City bureaus will be contacting the community soon to begin discussions about how this space can be improved and provide an enhanced community area.

Driveway access for property owners (including the one driveway on Holman) will be maintained.

The Bureau of Transportation is committed to keeping the impact to the park and park users at a minimum. The Bureau of Transportation would also maintain the bicycle pathway if repairs are necessary.

What is the schedule for construction?

The project is currently being designed by City engineers. This additional notice is to update the community about the design and obtain any further input or feedback from neighbors on the street. Construction will only be scheduled once the design of the features is completed. An additional notice will be sent once design has been completed. Construction is tentatively targeted for spring of 2011.
